Please bring any of the following to put in grocery carts that will be placed at the entrance of each church service on August 8th.

Blunt scissors (rounded tip)

30-centimeter ruler

Hand held pencil sharpener

Unsharpened pencils with erasers (no pictures or advertising)

Eraser, 2 1/2"

Box of 24 crayons (only 24)

Baby washcloths

Diaper pins

Pair sewing scissors

Package of needles

Spools of thread

5-8 matching buttons

Comb (large and sturdy, not pocket size and no rat tails)

Nail file or fingernail clippers (no emery boards or toenail clippers)

Bath size bar of soap (3 oz and up)

Toothbrush (single brushes only in original wrapper, No child-size brushes)

Adhesive plastic strip sterile bandages

\$1.00 to purchase toothpaste (UMCOR now buys in bulk to assure product does not expire)

Latex gloves or 1 pair of work gloves
