Sunday Morning

- PK3 through fifth grade: Programming is available for children PK3 through fifth grade from 6:30-7:30pm. Check in opens at 6:20pm.

SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION

We encourage you to register your camper(s) for summer camp at Warren W. Willis Camp in Leesburg (warrenwilliscamp.org) as soon as possible since weeks fill up quickly. First United Methodist staff is going July 15-20.

The church has funds available to assist with the cost of summer camp. Assistance is designed to help families who, due to limited financial resources, may otherwise be unable to participate. Return the First United Methodist Camp Scholarship Assistance Request (available at firstumc.org/camp) to the ministry area with whom the initial request was made (Children's Ministries, Youth Ministries, etc.). Every request will be considered. If awarded, scholarship funds are paid directly to the camp with the name of the camper on the remittance. If your child is unable to attend camp, funds will not be dispersed.

Due to the number of applications we receive, we encourage you to also apply for assistance directly from Warren W. Willis Summer Camp. A link to the Warren Willis scholarship application is available at firstumc.org/camp. Their deadline for scholarship applications is April 1, 2019.
